Dear Valued Clients,

This is to inform all third-party contractors, sub-contractors, and their personnel that MMT is extending the deadline for the submission of Contractor Registration Requirements under Advisory No. 2026-MMT-CN025.

1. Extension of Contractor Registration Deadline

The deadline for submission of all Contractor Registration Requirements is extended until **5:00 PM of July 31, 2026**. Please be advised that this is the **final extension**.

All contractors and sub-contractors who have not yet completed their registration are encouraged to submit the required documents to the HSSE Department (safety@mmt.ictsi.com) on or before the extended deadline. Applications with incomplete requirements may not be processed.

2. Ongoing Safety Induction Program

The Safety Induction Program for contractor personnel who have already submitted their registration requirements is currently ongoing and shall continue throughout the entire month of July 2026.

Contractor personnel are reminded that completion of the Safety Induction Program is a prerequisite for the issuance of the Safety ID, which authorizes personnel to work within the port facility.

3. Implementation of Safety ID Marking System

MMT has already commenced the implementation of the **Safety ID Marking System** last June 1, 2026 for contractor personnel who have already been issued their Safety IDs.

Personnel found committing safety and/or security violations within the port facility shall be subject to the corresponding marking, recording, and escalation procedures as provided under Advisory No. 2026-MMT-CN025.

4. Mandatory Carrying of Safety ID

Effective **July 1, 2026**, all third-party contractors, sub-contractors, and their personnel shall be required to carry and present their valid Safety ID when entering the port facility.

Contractor personnel who don't have a Safety ID yet because they have not attended the Safety Induction **shall still be allowed entry into the port facility but will be given a verbal warning by our Security to comply the requirement within the month of July.**

Contractor personnel who have completed the Safety Induction and have been issued Safety ID but fail to present them at the gate **shall not be allowed entry into the port facility** and shall not be permitted to perform any work or service activities within MMT.

All contractors are requested to ensure that their personnel complete the registration and Safety Induction requirements before the implementation date to avoid disruptions to their operations.
