Dear Valued Clients,

This is to remind all third-party contractors, sub-contractors, and their personnel that **starting August 1, 2026**, MMT shall **fully implement** its program on Third Party Contractor Registration and Issuance and Control of Safety Induction Cards (Safety IDs) for Third Party Contractor Personnel Requirements under Advisory No. 2026-MMT-CN025.

1. Continuation of Contractor Registration

The submission of all Contractor Registration Requirements shall be made continuous.

All contractors and sub-contractors who have not yet completed their registration are still encouraged to submit the required documents to the HSSE Department (safety@mmt.ictsi.com). Applications with incomplete requirements may not be processed.

2. Ongoing Safety Induction Program

The Safety Induction Program for contractor personnel who have already submitted their registration requirements shall continue as a regular program.

Contractor personnel are reminded that completion of the Safety Induction Program is a prerequisite for the issuance of the Safety ID, which authorizes personnel to work within the port facility.

3. Implementation of Safety ID Marking System

MMT has already commenced the implementation of the **Safety ID Marking System** last June 1, 2026 for contractor personnel who have already been issued their Safety IDs.

Personnel found committing safety and/or security violations within the port facility shall be subject to the corresponding marking, recording, and escalation procedures as provided under Advisory No. 2026-MMT-CN025.

4. Mandatory Carrying of Safety ID

Effective **August 1, 2026**, all third-party contractors, sub-contractors, and their personnel shall be required to carry and present their valid Safety ID when entering the port facility.

Contractor personnel who don't have a Safety ID yet because they have not attended the Safety Induction **shall not be allowed entry into the port facility until the safety registration requirements and induction has been completed.**

Contractor personnel who have completed the Safety Induction and have been issued Safety ID but fail to present them at the gate **shall not be allowed entry into the port facility** and shall not be permitted to perform any work or service activities within MMT.

Contractor personnel who have already attended the Safety Induction but have not received their Safety ID's yet – MMT Security will check if their names are in the database of those who've completed the induction but haven't received their Safety ID's yet, if confirmed they **can be allowed one-time entry into the port facility to get the Safety ID in our Safety Office** located at 3rd floor Operations Building.

All contractors are requested to ensure that their personnel complete the registration and Safety Induction requirements to avoid disruptions to their operations.
